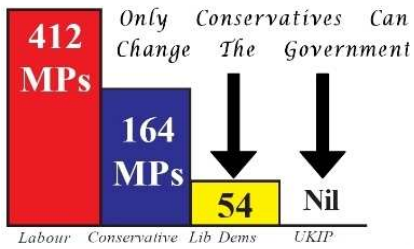

A361 Lay-bys

I agree wholeheartedly with Councillor David Butt's comments regarding these extra police lay-bys given to us for the Link road. David mentions the need for a Landkey junction particularly and the answer which he and cross-party colleagues have been given regularly is a "lack of resources".
